

MQHYA END OF YEAR AWARDS

To Qualify For End of The Year Awards with The MQHYA You Must Do the Following:

- Youth must be a current member of the MQHYA.
- All youth must purchase a MQHA back number.
- Youth are eligible for Youth End of Year Awards showing a horse owned by either themselves, their family or leased according to the terms of AQHA.
- If a youth shows a horse in open classes at a MQHA show, the horse owner **must** be a current member of MQHA in order for points to count toward End of Year Awards.
- All points are based on one horse/rider combination.
- Exhibitor/Horse combination must show in a **minimum of six MQHA** shows in the current calendar year to be eligible for awards.
- Exhibitor /Horse combo must have a **minimum of 10 MQHA points** during the current calendar year to be eligible for year-end awards. (Check MQHA by-laws to see how Montana points are tallied)
- All Youth **must participate** and sell a **minimum of five books** of Raffle tickets for the MQHYA fundraiser.
- A prize will be given to the youth who sells the most tickets.

- Monies raised from the raffle ticket sales will be allocated towards year-end awards, the more you sell the nicer the prizes!

- Year End awards will be given to the Top Two Montana Point Earners in each Novice Youth and Youth Class.
- Walk Trot Youth will be given an award for Participation as well. No minimum show/point requirements necessary. (They are the future and we need to inspire them!)
- Montana Rookie of the Year will be recognized with a plaque.
- All Around Awards will be given to the top Youth 14 to 18 point earner, the top Youth 13 and under point earner & the top Novice Youth point earner.

MQHYA reserves the right to cancel all prizes if the funding is not available.
